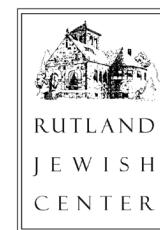

Dear Friends,

By now you’ve heard a bit about the RJC Sisterhood’s Centennial Cookbook, *Kosher Yankee Centennial: 100 Years of Jewish Cooking in Vermont*, in various announcements and newsletters. It’s that time, now—Recipe Collection is underway.

If you have Internet access, it’s amazingly simple to enter recipes using our cookbook publisher, Morris Press Cookbooks’ online recipe entry program. Here’s how:

1. **Got to [www.morriscookbooks.com](http://www.morriscookbooks.com)**. on the right is the link for the TypeNSave online entry of recipes.
2. In the GROUP LOGIN field, type **kosheryankee100** (all lowercase, no spaces)
3. Type in the password, **a6jaf** (again, all lowercase)
4. Start typing!

That’s it! Pretty simple. You can edit your recipe at any point until you click to save it. Once it is saved, you cannot make any changes or corrections. However, any member of the cookbook committee can help. Just send an email to the RJC office and the office manager will forward it.

Although we prefer recipes to be typed using the publisher’s software (it increases the accuracy of the information), if you don’t have Internet access, you can submit recipes using the form inside this flyer. **Please follow the instructions carefully.**

- List all ingredients in order of use in ingredients list and directions.
- Include container sizes, e.g., 16-oz. pkg., 24-oz. can.
- Keep directions in paragraph form \_ not in steps.
- Use names of ingredients in the directions, e.g., “Combine flour and sugar.” DO NOT use statements like, “Combine first three ingredients.”
- Include temperatures and cooking, chilling, baking, and/or freezing times.
- Please include any special notes or comments about the recipe
- Be consistent with the spelling of your name for each recipe you contribute.
- Your recipes should fit into the following categories:
